Spinifex wines are a happy fusion of the new and the old. An impeccable balance between the restraint and finesse of the Rhone, to which these wines owe their inspiration and their heritage, and the vibrancy of the unmistakable Barossa terroir. Together Peter Schell and Magali Gely have produced a stable of extraordinary wines since 2001. The remarkable 2009 vintage looks to be a watershed year in the short history of Spinifex. Added to an already great stable are two new wines; Le Chemin and Vallee de Roche; both beautifully moderate expressions of the inherent power of the Barossa Valley.

2009 SPINIFEX PAPILLON

Peter Schell is quite a pragmatic winemaker, while he makes wines in a restrained, almost European mould (although you would probably still pick them as new world) he has at his doorstep some of the best old vine Rhone grape varieties.

Probably the most Cotes du Rhone like in the whole range. Fresh cherries, spice and pepper aromas it's a fresh clean blend of Grenache, Cinsault & Mataro that has more peppery red fruits on the palate and ripe savoury tannins. The finish is one of freshness & brightness making another glass all too easy to drink. 2009 is shaping as a great vintage in the Barossa & whilst this is great drinking now it will gain further complexity over the next couple of years. **FWC**

2009 SPINIFEX ESPRIT

Rhone lovers rejoice. Here is a wine that effortlessly combines the best traditions of the old world with the ripe upfront fruit of the new. Even with the exchange rate as it is, this beats the Cote du Rhone style at its own game. The result is an extraordinary wine loaded with character, beautifully balanced with depth and complexity. A blend of Mataro, Grenache, Shiraz, Carignan and Cinsault, it is very much in the Cote du Rhone spectrum. Provincial herb, lavender and cherry spice are all melded together with beautiful bright harmony and balance. Fresh acidity and some fine tight tannins wrap up a sublime feminine wine that slips down the throat with consummate ease. **FWC**

2009 SPINIFEX INDIGENE

An amazing blend of Mataro and Shiraz, it's not Wendouree but boy it's one hell of a wine. Super complex nose with the Mataro coming through – rich and spiced, plum, cardamom, blue fruits, earth and rustic meaty notes. It's big but more elegant than the last couple of vintages. Tannins are rich and long from some whole bunch ferment. This tightens up the structure of the wine. A classic blend and highly recommended. **FWC**

2009 SPINIFEX LA MALINE SHIRAZ VIOGNIER

A blend of Barossa and Eden Valley fruit. This is the most modern of the Spinifex wines. The nose is pure raspberry, cherry and vanilla bean – very polished and aromatic. The palate is tightly focused with cherry, dark spices, a little toasty oak and bright acidity. Beautifully balanced and one of the best Shiraz Viognier's in Australia. **FWC**

2009 SPINIFEX TABOR MATARO

Peter Schell has not made this 100% Mataro wine since 2004. The wait has been worth it. The wine is powerful yet elegant with damp earth plum, blue fruits and walnutty notes. The 2009 Mataro fruit in the Barossa is possibly the best ever – dark and brooding yet with an elegance and freshness not normally seen from this variety. This great Mataro vintage is reflected in the 2009 Hewitson Old Garden, probably Hewitson's best ever. Tabor stock is very limited. **FWC**

2009 SPINIFEX VALLEE DES ROCHE

This is a 15 year old vineyard called "Rocky Valley" that Spinifex have sourced great Shiraz from for the past 6 years. The site is in a cooler part of the Barossa with some altitude. With Pete Schnell's winemaking talents it looks more like Clonakilla Shiraz Viognier than anything in the Barossa. It's very tightly coiled with bright black cherry, blue berry, star anise, brown spices and a lick of licorice/fennel. The fruit is at once powerful yet compact and restrained. It's "Long, cool and loaded." Extremely limited. **FWC**

2009 SPINIFEX LE CHENIN

This is a new wine from the outstanding 2009 vintage. It's co-fermented Grenache, Shiraz, Mataro, Carignan and Cinsault. Very bright red currant, pomegranate and tea leaf nose (not unlike great Cabernet Franc!) – quite intoxicating. The palate is very bright and fresh with great intensity. A complex wine with layers of red fruits, leafy herbal notes, warm cocoa, plum and under ripe stone fruit. It goes on and on and is quite unique. I love it. Very limited! **FWC**

TOP AUSTRALIAN GAMAY

SORRENBERG GAMAY 2010

The style of Gamay we produce is a combination of Burgundian and Beaujolais techniques. There is 10% Pinot Noir used in the blend. Half of the Gamay was cold macerated where the fruit is picked cold, crushed and left to soak for 4 days before fermentation starts. Of the rest, 20% of the fruit is left whole in the ferment. Fermentation with natural yeast is for 2 weeks on skins, after which the wine is pressed and matured in oak for eleven months.

The nose of the 2010 Gamay is at first restrained then opens out to show spicy cherry with a hint of black plum. The palate has these fruits combining with good clean natural acid and customary tannin. The length goes on, with hints of white pepper. This wine will cellar for 10 years plus.

Garry Morey continues to wow us with his Gamay, a wine that has gained a cult following over the years & deservedly so. The 2010 has a beautiful perfumed sour cherry note & red florals, almost Chianti like in it's fragrance. The palate is pure & rippling, with cherry pip, sappy red fruits & a sizzle of acidity that gives the wine a vitality & freshness. Easily rivals cru Beaujolais & whilst almost irresistible now it will gain pinot like complexity with medium term cellaring. Highly recommended. *FWC*

"Nick Farr is winemaker at his family winery in Geelong's Moorabool Valley. He's the son of the celebrated winemaker Gary Farr. Farr Rising is Nick's brand but maybe that should be Farr Aloft as he is a fine craftsman in his own right. This wine has a surprisingly deep red-purple colour and a layered bouquet of blackberry, leather and sap, showing some of the stemmy whole-bunch ferment character that typifies Farr pinots. It's rich, sweet-fruited and almost lush in the mouth, with soft tannins and silken texture. Lively acidity keeps it fresh and together. Drink now to 10 years. 95/100."
